## 132 AVENUE EAST COLLECTOR RENEWAL SCHOOL BULLETIN

Beginning in April 2026, 132 Avenue East starts Year 3 of Collector Renewal construction

Once complete, 132 Avenue will include one lane of traffic in each direction with a repaved road, widened sidewalks and new active transportation lanes. This ensures all Edmontonians can use 132 Avenue safely, whether they're walking, biking, rolling or driving.

### LANE CLOSURES

To accommodate construction, lane closures will be in effect starting April 20 until the end of the school year. **Two-way traffic will be maintained on 132 Avenue, with one lane of traffic in each direction.**

It's important to note, these closures will not change how you access St. Cecilia.

While access to the school is being maintained, the closures may result in additional traffic congestion in the area. It is recommended to leave extra travel time or use other options like public transportation.

At the end of June, 132 Avenue will be temporarily, fully closed from 90 Street to just west of 82 Street.

132 Avenue from 90 Street to 86 Street is scheduled to be reopened by the end of August, before the start of the 2026/2027 school year.

### BUS DETOURS

During construction, a number of ETS and school special routes will be detoured around the construction site. A temporary bus stop (marked in green on the map) will be available for the School Special routes on the east side of 90 Street, between 132 Avenue and 133 Avenue. ### ACCESS IMPACTS

To keep everyone safe during construction, the Project Team asks you to:

- Follow all signage and any site crew directions
- Drop children off from the passenger side of the vehicle
- Do not stop in driving lanes or crosswalks
- Use designated drop-off and pick-up zones, when available (identified on the map below)
- Find parking away from 132 Avenue, where possible, to assist with pick up and drop offs

The map at the bottom of this bulletin shows pick-up/drop-off zones, including a specific area for those with accessibility needs.

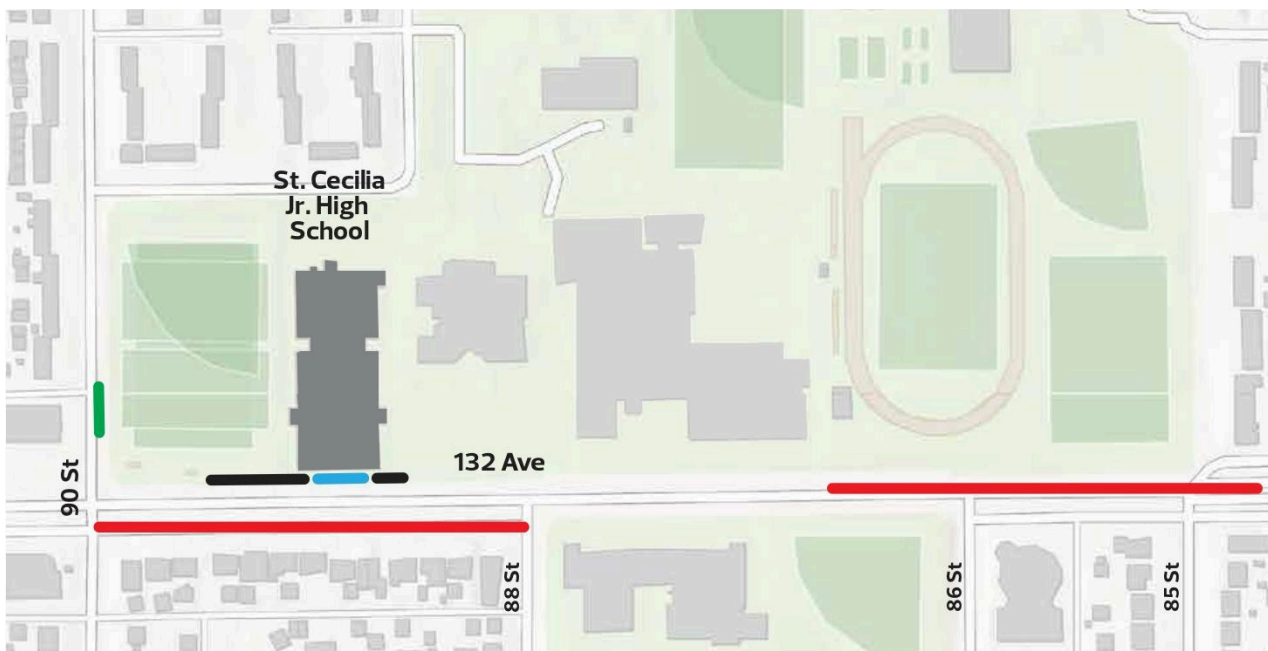
Two general pick-up/drop-off zones are located in front of St. Cecilia School. These zones are shown in black on the map.
