PROGRESS REPORTS

ECSD continues to work toward academic success for every student. To this end, parents can view ongoing reporting of student progress within PowerSchool. This allows parents to track their child's academic growth throughout the school year.

Parents can keep informed about their child's learning progress. Throughout the year teachers will enter students' marks as they assess curricular outcomes. They will also provide assignment information and offer feedback, when needed.

Progress summary reports are available online at the end of January and June. There are two reporting terms each of which include a demonstration of learning:

Note: As part of St. Cecilia School's commitment to supporting meaningful assessment and reporting practices, we are piloting a reporting model that does not use percentage grades. Beginning in the fall of 2026-2027, student achievement will be communicated through an overall Level of Achievement rather than a percentage grade. In addition, report cards will include Levels of Achievement for each curricular learning outcome, providing more detailed information about what students know, understand, and are able to do.

Each learning outcome will be assessed using our updated Levels of Achievement, shown below:



Levels of Achievement (LOA)	What This Means for Student Learning	Traditional Percentage Representation (%)
Standard of Excellence (SE)	Your child: - understands learning very well - uses learning in new ways - goes beyond expectations	91-100%
Proficient Standard+ (PR+)	Your child is at the Proficient Standard and is starting to demonstrate areas of excellence.	81-90%
Proficient Standard (PR)	Your child: - understands the learning - uses skills correctly - is meeting expectations	71-80%
Acceptable Standard+ (AS+)	Your child is at the Acceptable Standard and is starting to demonstrate areas of proficiency	61-70%
